What is the event for?

Children's Services and health services use the word transition to mean moving from child services to adult services. Most people do this between 16 and 19.

So what does this mean—well if you're a young person who receives a lot of services, maybe a disabled young person or you have complex health needs, it means the services you get will change and the people you are working with will change.

This event is for young people who are affected by this, to have a say on how this change should be handled and what you want out of transition.

How the event works

The programme for the day has been designed and run by a group of young people from The Young Ministers of Health Project. There will be two types of people attending this conference — young people and senior professionals who work with young people. The aim of the event is to give young people a chance to share their views with professionals about how they want to improve the transition process in the North West.
