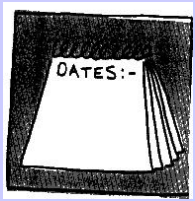
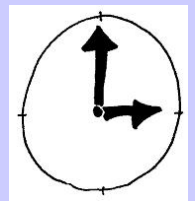

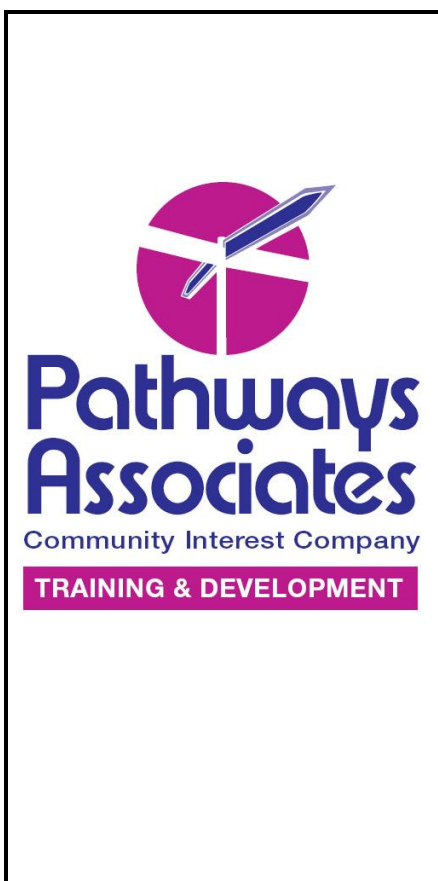

Pathways Associates Community Interest Company is committed to supporting individuals to take control of all aspects of their lives

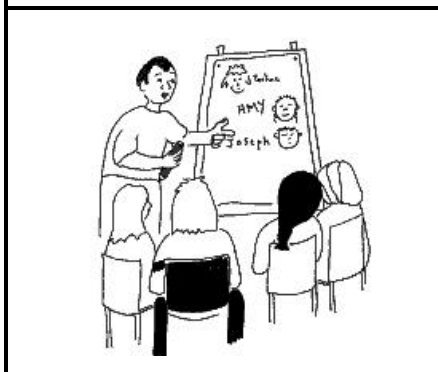
These were identified by disabled people and will, if met, enable them to fully participate in society and lead to people being in control of their own lives with the support they, at the level they need for as long as they need it.



